

Lancaster General Health Campus O.R. Instructions

At Parkside Dentistry P.C. we hope to provide your child with the best medical care in order to make their experience for dental treatment to be less anxious. Please remember that treatment always proceeds more smoothly when there is total parent cooperation and preparedness. If any of the following instructions are unclear to you, or if you have any questions, please do not hesitate to call the office prior to the scheduled appointment.

1. **ABSOLUTELY, NO FOOD** after 12 O'clock midnight the night before your scheduled hospital appointment. 12oz or **less** of clear liquids is allowed up to 3 hours prior to surgery.
2. **CHILDREN MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY HIS/HER PARENTS OR LEGAL GUARDIAN** and they must remain with them at the hospital until treatment is completed.
3. **No cough, cold, vomiting or fever.** If the child is sick, we must be informed, 1 week prior to the appointment, in order for us to evaluate if we should reschedule for another day. The physical form must be completed **within 2 weeks** prior to the appointment to make sure that the patient is healthy for surgery. If your child becomes ill after this physical is obtained **we must be notified immediately.** Please call Dr. Mathias at her emergency #:717-940-9489 if your child has an emergency or sickness if after hours the weekend before scheduled surgery.
4. **FAILURE TO SHOW UP** at the hospital or if patient eats or drinks anything besides clear liquids on morning of surgery appointment there will be a \$350.00 missed appointment charge!! The hospital operating room has been reserved for your child. **IF YOU NEED TO RESCHEDULE WE MUST BE NOTIFIED ONE WEEK PRIOR TO SURGERY!!**
